The 2006 slalom schedule was discussed.

- There were many dates available for TAC #0 and Feb 12 was chosen by vote of the committee.
- In order to have events at Joe Davis Stadium we need to purchase 4 season ticket box seats at \$375 each (to be split between TAC and TVR). This was voted and unanimously approved by the committee.
- Use of the Milton Frank site is being mostly avoided early in the season so we do not compromise the site before the TVR Divisional.
- TAC #2 was moved to May 6 as it gets the date further away from Mother's Day and accommodates some people's schedules.
- Some dates are being reserved for Joe Davis and John Hunt Park so we have a backup location.
- The city has requested that we not have the night slalom at the same time as the haunted house so it will be earlier in the month.
- There was no interest in the committee for two-day events, except the divisional.

The Championship Points Series was discussed.

- By unanimous vote of the committee, the divisional will be excluded from the series due to the SCCA membership requirement for that event.
- By unanimous vote of the committee, the TVR event before the school will be part of the series.

Insurance for 2006 will be going up 10%. TAC made good money last year so this should not be a problem.

TAC will continue to charge a \$10 surcharge for pass holders at Milton Frank events. The committee agreed that the Slalom Pass charge for 2006 should be increased to \$90. Trophies for last year were discussed

- Something that shows the finishing position would be nice
- Price is an issue
- The lack of need for the event master to deal with trophies last year was nice
- The committee voted unanimously to not purchase the glasses again for this year ahead of time. Event masters are still free to do as they wish.

Start times were discussed

- It is suggested that the driver's meeting be done before the novice meeting and let the experienced drivers head to cars and workstations during the novice meeting.
- Having worker stations assigned and ready to be called out during the driver's meeting.

FTY/PAX scoring was discussed

Having karts does affect the scoring when the kart is the fastest. The committee
voted unanimously to change the rules to normalize these scores by the fastest
non-kart.
