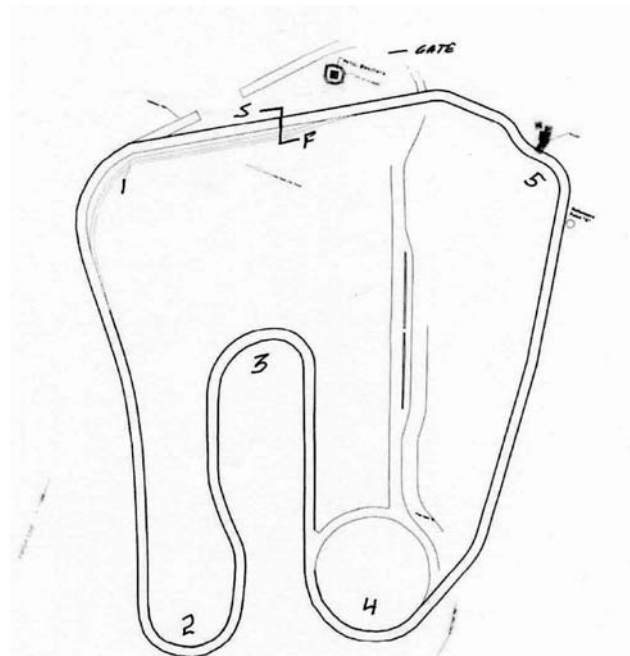

Talladega Gran Prix Raceway is a 1.41 mile road course located on Alabama State Highway 21, 12 miles south of Oxford, Alabama, and 8 miles north of Talladega, Alabama. The track has showers, restrooms, compressed air and 114 octane fuel. Overnight camping is permitted. The track gate will be locked each evening at 10:30 p.m. There is a payphone at the track (256-362-9985). The caller should ask to have their party paged. The track concession stand WILL BE OPEN for breakfast and lunch, Saturday and Sunday from 7:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Event Headquarters will be at the Track.

There are several very nice hotels located 12 miles north of the track, in Oxford, AL.

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SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

Sanction #07-TT-17-S

This event will be held under the 2007 SCCA General Competition Rules (GCR) as amended by the 2006 or 2007 SCCA Time Trials Rules (TTR), and as further amended by the 2007 "FASTTRACK". Further amendments may also be published in these Supplemental Regulations.

REGISTRATION: Entry forms must be completed and mailed with your check to Craig Farr, 152 Nale Drive, Madison, AL 35758 256-325-0759 (**No calls after 9:00pm CDT please**). Make check payable to TVR, SCCA. Late entries will be served at Registration, as per the schedule. A \$25 fee will be charged for any check returned by the bank. Entry forms postmarked after May 25 will be required to pay the late entry fee. A full refund will be made if the entry is withdrawn prior to tech. A \$25 fee will be charged anyone who does not withdraw and is a no-show.

STUDENTS: If you desire to receive a Time Trials Competition License (eligible to compete at hill climbs), you should obtain a physical examination using the "2007 Physical Exam for SCCA Competition". Otherwise, you may receive a TT Novice License until you complete your physical examination. Call your Region or see www.SCCA.org for the medical exam form.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY: Holders of **current** SCCA National or Regional Competition License, Time Trials Novice Licenses, Time Trials Competition License, FIA License (if SCCA member), or SCCA Competition License Novice Permit may compete in this event. Time Trials Novice Licenses will be available at this event. Safety gear must meet GCR and TTR requirements.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY: Open to all vehicles conforming to the GCR and TTR, as amended. IT7, Club Ford, SPO, SPU, and GT America will compete under the SEDiv approved rules. Street Prepared and Street Modified will compete under the Solo Rules. Rally cars will compete under the Rally America Rules and will be classed as SPU or SPO. SEDiv Time Trials reserved numbers will be held until May 31. Otherwise, numbers will be issued on a first come, first served basis. For two driver cars, add the numeral "1" to the primary driver's number (e.g., 1st driver 59, second driver 159).

TIME TRIALS SCHOOL RUNNING ORDER: School drivers will be staged at pit exit together. If you catch the car ahead of you, slow down, raise your hand and return to the pits for a rerun. **NO PASSING.**

UNTIMED PRACTICE RUNNING ORDER: Cars will be allowed on the track as they present themselves to the Pit/Grid Marshal. There may be multiple cars on the course at any given time. Untimed practice on Saturday will alternate with School participants on track as per the attached schedule. Passing will be allowed on the designated straights with a point by from the driver being overtaken per Special Time Trials Event regulations.

TIME TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIP RUNNING ORDER: Groups may be combined at the recommendation of the Chief Steward. Each run may consist of a warm-up lap, three (3) hot laps, and a cool down lap. Specific instructions will be given at the MANDATORY Driver's Meeting.

SCALES are NOT available at this event.

WAIVER: Everyone entering the track **must** sign both the track and SCCA waiver. Passes must be shown to enter the track. There will be no exceptions.

TECH: All driver and vehicle safety equipment must meet current GCR and TTR specifications for a Level 3 Event. Driver's head/ helmet to roll bar/roll cage clearance must meet the requirements of GCR and TTR. Roll bar/roll cage padding is required per the GCR and TTR. Cars must be re-inspected by the Chief of Tech if involved in an incident or if the vehicle is reported as leaking any fluids. All entrants must have a vehicle log book complete with pictures and log

book number. Please fill in the date and event name prior to visiting tech. Arm restraints are required on all open cars. ****Note:** Student Tech will be performed on Friday night at the base of the tower. All students must present their cars and safety equipment at that time. The Championship Event entrants' technical inspections will be conducted with "roaming" tech inspectors. Please have your tech sheet filled out completely and placed on the windshield/front of your car and have your car and gear ready for inspection.

HELMETS: All helmets must be SA00 or later. M-RATED OR SA-95 HELMETS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.

TRANSPONDERS: TGPR will have an AMB Transponder loop which will be used for this event. Competitors without an AMB transponder must rent one for the weekend for a fee of \$35.00. Each vehicle renting a transponder will require a special bracket into which the transponder may be quickly attached. If you have not retained your bracket from previous events, they will be available for a small fee. Rental will require a \$375 deposit check to be left with registration to assure return of the transponder at the end of the event. Fifty five rental transponders are available, so registration will be limited to 55 entries plus competitors already having an AMB transponder.

INSURANCE: Participant insurance will be provided in at least the minimum amount required by the SCCA.

PADDOCK: You may park anywhere in the paddock provided you do not block the main paddock roads, pit entrance, pit exit areas, concession, tower or other specially marked areas. A pit and paddock speed limit of 5 mph will be strictly enforced.

EMERGENCY LANES must be clear at all times for emergency traffic.

INTOXICANTS: Use of intoxicants prior to the end of the day's events is prohibited. Anyone found to be using intoxicants during the event, or illegal drugs at any time while on the property, will be ejected from the property. Drivers are responsible for their crew and guests.

TALLADEGA GRAN PRIX RACEWAY'S GATES will be locked at 8:00 PM of the last day of the event. Please be off the premises by that time.

GENERAL RULES: The track concession stand will be open for breakfast at 7:00 am and lunch both days. ***It is recommended that you not bring pets to the track.*** However, if you do bring your pet, it must remain restrained (leash, cage, pin, etc.) at all times. Do not dump oil, gas or coolant anywhere. Take your fluids home. You must take everything you bring to the track with you when you leave. Use caution and common sense when raising your car and supporting it on jack stands. The paddock area is grass, not pavement, so it is recommended that you use plywood or metal plates beneath your jacks and jack stands. No glass containers are allowed on the property. Anyone riding an atv or motorized scooter must be a licensed driver and wear a helmet. An entrant may elect to waive SEDiv TT Series points by checking the appropriate box on the entry form. Passengers are NOT permitted in any racing vehicle.
